Refugees on Manus Island

Sunday 23rd November – 6pm at Belmont UC Thomson St. Belmont

The Belmont/St Luke's Social Issues Committee has arranged for Mr Jason Brown to speak about his experiences working at Manus Island detention centre. A light meal will follow the presentation.

Jason is a Geelong resident and a former counsellor with International Health and Medical Services at the Manus Island regional centre PNG. He had two separate months at IHMS working as a mental health clinician to the 1,350 asylum seekers. While there, he conducted mindfulness relaxation group sessions, one-on-one counselling and health education presentations.

Join us to hear about his work and experiences in the centre. Donations to RAR (Rural Australians for Refugees) will be used to help supply educational support for refugees attending Western Heights Uniting Church.
